

SJGS eLearning 2.0

What is eLearning 2.0?

eLearning 2.0 is a way for us to provide instruction for students and families who may have underlying health conditions or are otherwise uncomfortable sending their children to school.

How does it work?

- The first three days of school, August 19-21 will be orientation and some live community building opportunities. These days will be more synchronous so our students do not miss out on the excitement that comes with a new school year.
- Students and parents have access to instructional material in Google Classroom (GC). Some instruction may come as videos, which could be delayed as much as 24 hours.
- Students will receive information to log into a required Google Meet or Zoom for scheduled times to meet with peers in small groups about Math and Language Arts each week. Once a week a time will be scheduled for optional (but encouraged!) community building with the class.
- Students will indicate attendance at the start of each day by completing a Google Form in the GC.
- Specials instruction and work will also be found in GC.
- Students will be able to ask questions through GC and engage with peers with scheduled meeting times.
- A list of other students doing eLearning 2.0 in your student's grade will be provided for collaboration opportunities.
- Hardcopy materials will need to be picked up from school each Friday between 1:30 PM - 3:30 PM. The first day for material pick up will be Friday, August 28th. Please know that there may be adjustments during the course of the week based on whether teachers need to reteach or reinforce. There may need to be items printed in some circumstances.

Steps for transitioning to eLearning 2.0 if you need to quarantine:

- Contact the school - call the office at 574-234-0451 during business hours or email Mr. Azar at gazar@stjosephgradeschool.com.
- Within 1 business day parents will need to pickup hardcopy materials
- Information will be emailed home from Mrs. Howard or Mrs. Gelchion.
- An orientation with student and parent will be scheduled
- Students will begin schedule

What does eLearning 2.0 look like during the week?

- Students will complete a Google Form in their Google Classroom (GC) each day they are in attendance (able to complete school work, not sick)
- Students will complete assignments on GC for the class and day
- Two times per week students will participate in small groups sessions with other students doing eLearning 2.0 in the same grade. One session will focus on Math

concepts from the week and one session will focus on Language Arts concepts from the week.

- One time per week, students will participate in Community Building with their Homeroom class. This will be a live stream.
- Once per week students will have the opportunity to participate in a recorded prayer service or mass.
